Dear Mr. Olfman,

I am writing in response to your letter of November 17, 2014 to CBC board chair Remi Racine. You have raised concerns about a story posted to the CBC website on June 24, 2014.

This was a story, written by Canadian Press, relating to a written decision released by Justice Chris Martin of Manitoba Court of Queen's Bench.

The story conveyed the basic facts of Mr. Justice Martin's judgment to uphold the decision of the master to strike the statement of claim at issue in the case. Notwithstanding some minor inconsistencies which you have noted -- such as whether it was the original or the revised statement of claim which was 154 pages in length -- we believe the story as posted accurately conveyed the essence of Mr. Justice Martin's decision, which was to strike the statement of claim. The link to a related story also provided additional context for the original lawsuit.
